AMENDMENTS TO THE GUIDELINES ON THE
CONTINUING PROGRAM ON GUIDANCE

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges
and Universities

1. The second phase of the MEC PhilanLife Scholarship Program in Guidance will start during the second semester instead of at the beginning of school year 1978-1979 as indicated in Department Memorandum No. 138, s. 1978.

2. Accordingly, the following dates have been set for the various steps/activities of the program:

a. June 17, 1978 - Receipt of application forms and information sheets by the MEC regional offices from Philippine American Life Insurance Company, Manila

b. July 17, 1978 - Last day for submission of names of candidates by the division school superintendents to the regional office

c. July 31, 1978 - Deadline for submission of the nomination forms of five (5) nominees by each regional director to:

d. Aug. 14-31,
1978 - Testing and interview of nominees by MEC-UP team

e. Oct. 6, 1978 - Final selection of scholars by the MEC-PhilanLife-UP Scholarship Committee

f. Oct. 16-31, 1978 - Announcement of scholars, orientation, and pre-enrolment activities

g. Nov. 3, 1978 - Registration in the university by the scholars

3. Since the scholarship grants are available to qualified teachers/guidance counselors of both private and public schools, the stipulation is that the MEC or the private school, as the case may be, will continue to pay the salaries of their scholars for the duration of the scholarship grant covering two summers and three semesters (or nineteen months). In this connection, therefore, private schools that are not in a position to comply with this proviso need not submit nominees for the scholarship.

4. In case teacher-nominees from private schools are finally chosen, the private school concerned, just like the public schools, will be required to sign an agreement with the Philippine American Life Insurance Company to the effect that they are willing to pay their teacher-scholars their full salary while on study leave.

5. Attention is invited to portions of Department Memorandum No. 138, s. 1978, regarding other requirements which still hold.

6. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
