SEVENTH SEMINAR-CONFERENCE OF THE PHILIPPINE
ELEMENTARY SCHOOL PRINCIPALS ASSOCIATION

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents

1. The Seventh Seminar-Conference of the Philippine Elementary School Principals Association will be held from July 26 to 29, 1978 in Manila, with the Opening Ceremony at the Philamlife Auditorium and the succeeding sessions at the Aurora A. Quezon Elementary School on San Agustin, Makati. The theme of the conference is "The Elementary School Principals and Countryside Development."
2. Lectures, forum, and work sessions will aim to carry out the following objectives:
 - a. Orient principals on the new thrusts of the MEC in relation to countryside development;
 - b. Formulate plans to implement such thrusts in the light of conditions obtaining in the different regions or divisions; and
 - c. Keep attuned to new developments within the system that affect the teachers and other school personnel.
3. Each division is allowed to send two delegates from the public elementary schools, preferably the president of the local chapter and one designated by the division superintendent. This limitation does not apply to the officers and directors of the Philippine Elementary School Principals Association (PESPA), conference officials, and members of the working committees. Private schools are invited to send an delegation to the conference.

4. The names of the delegates must be submitted to the DEPSA Secretary, Bureau of Queen Elementary School, San Andres, Malate, Manila, with a copy furnished this Office on or before July 15, 1978.

5. A conference fee of P200 will be charged each participant. Participants coming from outside Metro Manila shall be entitled to travelling and meal allowances at rates no higher than authorized by COA rules and regulations. All expenses not authorized by COA rules and regulations are those owing from the two Manila shall be entitled to reasonable transportation allowance only. Expenses of participants shall be chargeable against the appropriations of their respective school divisions.

6. Within 30 days after the seminar, the participants shall submit a report to the school division/region office. The Association shall likewise submit to the Office of the President a report of evaluation, including a list of participants coming from the government sector with their respective positions and a statement of fees collected and expenditures incurred, duly certified by a Certified Public Accountant, with a copy furnished the Budget Commission.
