1978 NATIONAL ALAY TANNIN CONTEST

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Chiefs of Services and Heads of Units
Coordinator, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities
School Superintendents

1. The Third National Alay Tannin Contest will be conducted from July 1, 1978 to March 31, 1979.
2. Unlike Phase II of the national Alay Tannin contest which concentrated on the number of fruit and ornamental trees planted per division, this contest (Phase III) calls for the evaluation of the implementation of the nutrition program, orchard development and environmental education in all school divisions from Regions I to XII.
3. It is requested that each region select one division entry which must be submitted on or before September 15, 1978 to the National Evaluation Committee, MEO, Manila - Attention: Director, School Health and Nutrition Center (SHNC). The names of members of the national and regional evaluation teams are found in the inclosure to this Memorandum.
4. The national evaluation team will start evaluating each division entry on October 15, 1978. Winners will be announced and certificates of appreciation will be awarded in January, 1979. In accordance with paragraph 4 of LO 586 one (1) schoolhouse including construction cost will be awarded to each of the regional and national Alay Tannin winners.
5. The following guidelines may be used as basis for the selection of the regional and national winners:
 - a. Nutrition Program - Implementation of the food production, feeding program, health education and services.

- b. Orchard Development - availability of regional and division orchard master plan, management and quality of maintenance of the model orchards, number of living trees in accordance with the development plan, number of mini-orchards within the division; 1978 quarterly reports submitted and received by the National Evaluation Committee, CHED, INC, Manila.
- c. Environmental Education - proper utilization of natural resources within the school site, recycling of waste materials, conservation of water, soil, plants and animals.
- d. Number of varieties or kinds of medicinal plants being cultured.
- e. Ratio of living trees planted per enrolment as of October 1978.
- f. Regional reports submitted on the number of living fruit trees, forest trees, and ornamental trees planted in 1977.

6. Immediate dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum is enjoined.
