## CONFERENCE ON "BILINGUAL EDUCATION FOUR YEARS AFTER AND BEYOND"

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Chiefs of Services and Keads of Units
Coordinator, State Colleges and Universities
Schools Superintendents
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

- The Ministry of Education and Culture, with the assistance of the Surian og Wikang Pambanea, the Linguistic Society of the Philippines, and the Philippine Association for Language Teaching, will sponsor a conference on "Bilingual Education Four Years After and Beyond" on October 19-20, 1978 at the Health Education Auditorium of the Philippine Morgal College.
- The purpose of the conference is to make a realistic assessment of how the Bilingual Education Policy (Espertment Order No. 25, s. 1974) is being implemented in Tagalog and non-Tagalog regions, the practical difficulties being met in the field, and possible solutions and remedies to meet these difficulties.
- 3. For each region, the regional supervisors in charge of Pilipino, English, Social Studies, Mathematics-Science or their representatives should be sent to the conference to inform the group concerning the implementation of the program and the practical problems being mat.
- 4. A knowledgeable representative from each of the fourteen Regional Staff Devalopment Centers under EDPITAF should likewise be sent to report on the use of the materials and staff devalopment problems.
- 5. Finally, the person in charge of implementation of the Bilingual Education Policy in each of the eight state colleges and universities should attend and report on his individual institution.
- 6. Representatives may be sent on official time and with local funds being used. The conference fee is \$50.
