OBSERVANCE OF THE THIRTIETH ANNIVERSARY OF THE  
UNIVERSAL DECLARATION OF HUMAN RIGHTS

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Coordinator, State Colleges and Universities  
Schools Superintendents  
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges  
and Universities

1. The thirtieth anniversary of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights will be observed in all countries which are members of the United Nations on December 10, 1978.
2. The Philippines as one of the members of this international organization, believing in all its principles, has committed herself to join in this celebration.
3. A special feature of this celebration is the selection of candidates for the award of Human Rights Prize that will be given by the United Nations Office. Recommendations for this honor may be submitted to this Office on or before August 20, 1978 so as to enable the office concerned to submit them to the United Nations Office at Geneva on September 1, 1978.
4. In connection with the day's observance, the Ministry of Education and Culture enjoins all schools, in all levels, all over the country to prepare a program of activities that will bring awareness to all citizens of the important role all nations play in the preservation of human rights.
5. A report on this activity shall be expected from all regions of the MEC.
6. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
