NATIONAL WORKSHOP ON EDUCATIONAL TECHNOLOGY WITH
SPECIAL REFERENCE TO DEVELOPMENT OF
LOW-COST EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS

1. The Ministry of Education and Culture, in cooperation with the Asian Center of Educational Innovation for Development, UNESCO Regional Office for Education, Bangkok, Thailand, will conduct a national workshop in educational technology with special reference to the development of low-cost educational materials, on August 21-25, 1978 at the Lemery Pilot Training Center in Batangas.
2. The objectives, expected outcomes and various activities of the workshop and the list of participants are enclosed.
3. Participants are requested to bring along as many model teacher-pupil-prepared educational materials as possible, with the accompanying instruction sheets, which will be exhibited at the workshop. They should also bring along some indigenous raw materials and work implements which can be used in the preparation of low-cost educational materials.
4. Per diems and transportation expenses to Lemery, Batangas and return of participants from the state colleges, including PNC, curriculum development centers and office units are chargeable against the funds of their respective offices, while those of the division educational media supervisors from the 13 regions and members of the EID taskforce are chargeable against the funds of this Office subject to the usual accounting and auditing regulations.

5. The selected participants are expected to organize and conduct similar workshops in their respective regions or nations.

6. It is requested that this memorandum be disseminated immediately.

1. Displays of low-cost/simple materials produced within the country and games and toys being used in the country.
2. Demonstrations on the use of materials being collected.
3. Designing and production of model low-cost/simple materials with instructional sheets.
4. Identifying/classifying un-used and under-utilized materials and innovative techniques and methods for production of low-cost/simple educational materials.
