MEMORANDUM
No. 223-S. 1978

MANILA, PHILIPPINES, OCTOBER 10, 1978

To: Regional Directors

1. This Office made representations with the Acting Commissioner of the Budget for the continuance of the representation and transportation allowances of DEC (now DEDC) officials who, under previous authorization from the Office of the President, received these allowances, but which were stopped effective January 1, 1978, pursuant to Section 17, General Provisions, of P.D. No. 1280.
2. Among these officials are assistant chiefs of division in the DEC proper and regional offices, vocational school administrators, and the administrative assistants in the three staff bureaus and the National Educational Testing Center.
3. This Office also recommended that all assistant division superintendents be allowed to collect the same allowances at the rate of ₱100 each per month.
4. These representations were, however, denied by the Minister of the Budget, in a letter to this Office, dated June 27, 1978 for the reason that these positions "are not among those enumerated in the said Section 17, of General Provisions, P.D. No. 1280," except for the position of "vocational school administrator, who heads a vocational school offering two-year post secondary technical courses," and "is considered comparable to position under Career Executive Service Rank V."
5. In view thereof, the list of DEC (now DEDC) regional officials authorized to collect transportation and representation allowances, inclosure to Department Memorandum No. 1978, is hereby revised so as to include the position of "vocational school administrator, with transportation and representation allowances at ₱100 each per month on a reimbursement basis".
6. This Memorandum should be disseminated to all concerned.
