1978 YEAR-END SCIENCE FAIR AND SCIENCE QUIZ

TO: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Coordinator, State Colleges and Universities
Schools Superintendents
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. The Science Foundation of the Philippines, in pursuit of its program on public understanding of science, technology and environment, is holding this year's Science Fair and Science Quiz in selected places throughout the country.

2. The theme of the year-end Science Fair and Quiz is "Identification and Utilization of Indigenous Resources: Key to Countryside Development." The major focus of the exhibits and the quiz will be on food and nutrition, and energy and pollution.

3. Inclosed are the Guidelines for the 1978 Science Fair and Science Quiz mentioning, among others, the qualifications and requirements for participation as well as the conduct and schedules of these activities from the sub-regional to national levels.

4. Attention is invited to the following salient information given in the guidelines:

- a. The sub-regional science exhibit and science quiz shall be held on November 13-17, and November 16, 1978, respectively, in the towns and cities as indicated in the guidelines. In Region VI, however, a regional evaluation of the outstanding science projects at the division level will be held on November 13-14, and a regional science quiz on November 16, in Iloilo City in lieu of the sub-regional contests.

b. The outstanding projects and awardees in the sub-regional contests as well as in the Regional Science Fair Evaluation in Region VI will automatically be the finalists in the national contests to be held in Cebu City on December 4-8.

c. The contests shall be open to all members of Youth Science Clubs, in-school and out-of-school, as follows:

1) Age levels 8-12; 13-18 years for the science fair.

2) Age level 13-18 years for the science quiz.

d. The deadline for submission of applications for participation is October 16.

5. In view of the educative nature of these science activities as a complement to classroom instruction, the participation of science club members is highly enjoined. Science club advisee science supervisors, department heads and school administrators are likewise encouraged to attend these contests on official time with their expenses chargeable against local funds.

6. It is desired that the contents of this Memorandum be disseminated immediately to ensure as wide a participation as possible among our studentry and the other school personnel who are most directly concerned.

I. THEME: "Identification and Utilization of Indigenous Resources: Key to Countryside Development"

II. DATES:

Sub-Regional Science Fair	13-17 November 1978
National Science Fair	4-8 December 1978

III. NATURE OF SCIENCE FAIR PROJECTS: (Undertaken by a member of, a group in or by the whole science club)

1. Investigatory projects on Food and Nutrition, Energy, and Pollution with emphasis on the theme.
2. Demonstrations and applications of a scientific principle or an attempt to prove a new concept.
3. Results of continuing or parallel scientific researches or investigations.
4. Investigatory projects with socio-economic utility values and relevance to countryside development.

IV. QUALIFICATIONS OF PROJECT-INVESTIGATORS:

A. Sub-Regional Level (One of two to be held in a Region)

1. Members of school or out-of-school science club;
2. Between 13-18 years old for the secondary level and between 8-12 years old for the elementary level on the date of the National Science Fair;
3. Winners in the local science fair;
4. Not participants in the 1978 Year-End Science Quiz; and
5. Have not taken any subject in a post-secondary school course.

B. National level

Outstanding projects in the Sub-Regional Science Fair or in the Regional Science Fair evaluation (in Region VI).

V. REQUIREMENTS FOR PARTICIPATION:

Items to be submitted to the nearest SFP Field Science Service Center (Science Promotions Office):

1. Application for Participation;

16 October 1978.

VI. SITES:

- A. The Sub-Regional Science Fair will be held throughout the fourteen (14) regions in the country, except in Region VI where a Division Level Science Fair will be conducted at any place to be designated by the Division Superintendent of Schools concerned. In lieu of the Sub-Regional Science Fair, a regional evaluation of the outstanding science projects in the division will be conducted by a committee in Iloilo City to select participating projects for the National Science Fair.

II. DATES:

A. Sub-Regional Science Quiz	16 November 1978
B. National Science Quiz	7 December 1978

III. TEST COVERAGE:

The type of test will be objective and situational with emphasis on science processes applied to the program thrust of the government on Farm Credit, Nutrition, Energy and Pollution.

IV. QUALIFICATIONS OF PARTICIPANT:

A. Sub-Regional Level (One of two in a Region)

1. Member of a school or out-of-school science club;
2. Between 13-18 years old on the date of the National Science Quiz;
3. Winner in the local quiz;
4. Has not participated in any previous national science quiz;
5. Has not taken any subject in a post-secondary school course;
6. Not a participant in the 1978 Year-End Science Fair; and
7. Not related up to the second degree of consanguinity or affinity to any employee of the SFP.

B. National Level -

Outstanding awardee in the Sub-Regional Science Quiz.

V. REQUIREMENTS FOR SUBMISSION BY THE APPLICANT:

A. Application for participation to be submitted to the nearest SFP Field Science Service Center (Science Promotions Office);

B. Application for participation forms may be secured from any of the SFP Field Science Service Center or in the SFP Central Office, Bicutan, Taguig, Metro Manila.

C. Deadline for submission of requisites for participation papers is 16 October 1978.

A. The Sub-Regional Science Quiz will be held ~~in~~ in the fourteen regions in the country, except in Region VI where a Division Level Quiz will be held at any place to be designated by the Division Superintendents.


