MEC-PATI-PAPE SPONSORED ORIENTATION CONFERENCE ON THE
EXPERIMENTAL ELEMENTARY EDUCATION PROGRAM (EEEP)

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Coordinator, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges
and Universities

1. In articulation with the Bureau of Elementary Education tryout of the Experimental Elementary Education Program in 125 school divisions for two years beginning this school year 1978-1979, regional orientation conferences, jointly sponsored by the Ministry of Education and Culture, the Philippine Association for Teacher Education (PATI) and the Fund for Assistance to Private Education (PAPE) will be held from September 11 to October 16, 1978, for representatives of teacher training institutions in the country.
2. The regional orientation conference aim to:
 - a. Familiarize heads of educators with the salient features of the Experimental Elementary Education Program (EEEP),
 - b. Make teacher educators aware of the implementation scheme and guidelines of the EEEP,
 - c. Derive implications of the program to the teacher education program, and
 - d. Formulate plans, programs and curriculum reforms for the training of future teachers who will eventually man the classes using the revised curriculum.
3. Participants in the conference will include the following:
(1) school administrator of the teacher training institution (public and private), (2) dean of the College/Faculty of Education (Elementary Education) and (3) principal of the laboratory school/elementary training department. Each teacher training institution may send a maximum of three (3) delegates/representatives to the conference. In this connection, heads of teacher training institutions, public and private, are requested to send the names of their delegates to the office of the PATI President, Philippine Christian University, Taft Ave., Manila, before August 31, 1978.

4. Travel expenses and registration fee of one hundred fifty pesos (P150) for meals and lodging of the participants will be provided by the respective education institution concerned while meals, lodging and travel expenses of consultants and resource persons as well as snacks and materials for handouts of all participants will be borne by the FAPE.

5. Inclosed is the Tentative Schedule of the Orientation Conferences.

6. Wide and immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is earnestly requested.
