SLOGAN CONTEST FOR THE 1978 CONSUMERS' PROTECTION WEEK

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Coordinator, State Colleges and Universities
Schools Superintendents
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges
and Universities

1. In connection with the celebration of 1978 Consumers' Protection Week on October 23-26, the Ministry of Education and Culture, in coordination with the National Federation of Women's Clubs of the Philippines, the Food Nutrition Research Institute, the U.P. Law Center, the Ministry of Local Government and Community Development and the National Science Development Board, will hold a slogan contest on the regional and national levels on the theme, "Pataas na Malagan ng Pamumuhay: Suliranin ng Konsiyumen."
2. The competition is open to all students in all schools in all levels, as well as out-of-school youths, throughout the country.
3. The regional slogan competition will be conducted in the MEC regional offices. The national slogan competition will be conducted in Manila.
4. The venue and date of the regional slogan competition will be designated by the MEC regional director as chairman, in coordination with the regional NSDB science field supervisor as co-chairman, and the regional NLGCB director as member. The regional Bureau of Domestic Trade supervisor, if there is one in the region, will act as secretary.
5. The following are the guidelines of the contest:
 - a. Slogan should be in Pilipino.
 - b. Slogan should be limited to ten words only.
 - c. Each entry should be submitted in typewritten form, double spaced and should bear the complete name of the contestant, grade level, school, division, and region.
 - d. Only one entry per contestant is allowed.
 - e. All slogan entries should be submitted to the MEC regional director not later than September 30, 1978.

5. The evaluation of the regional level competition is final. Board of judges for the regional competition should be composed of:

- MDC regional representative as chairman
- MOOE regional representative as member
- BJC supervisor as secretary

6. Regional winners should be announced not later than September 30, 1978.

7. A certified list of names, grade level and school of the participants for the regional slogan competition, duly signed by the regional organization chairman and the winning slogans should be sent directly to:

8. All entries for the National slogan contest should be received by MEC, Manila on or before October 7, 1978. Only winning slogans certified by the chairman of the regional slogan competition, supported by the report of the board of judges stamp received by MEC not later than October 7, 1978 shall be qualified for the National Slogan contest. The decision of the board of judges over the national level is final.

9. Prizes donated by the Ministry of Trade are as follows:

a. Regional Level

Each region:

One (1) First Prize	7300 + Trophy
One (1) Second Prize	7200 + Plaque
One (1) Third Prize	7100 + Certificate

b. National Level

One (1) First Prize	10000 + Trophy
One (1) Second Prize	7750 + Plaque
One (1) Third Prize	5500 + Certificate

10. The awarding ceremonies for the regional contests should be held on October 23, the first day of the Consumers' Protection Week, while the awarding ceremonies for the national competition will be held at 1:00 O'clock in the afternoon of October 29 at the Philippine International Convention Center, Metro Manila.

11. Winners in the national level contest are expected to attend the awarding ceremonies. Transportation expenses and per diem will be provided by the region where they belong, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules.

11. Intermediate classification of this Memorandum is desired.
