SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON THE PLANNING AND MANAGEMENT
OF VOCATIONAL SKILLS COMPETITIONS

1. The educational system is charged with the responsibility of developing and training the nation's manpower in critical skills required for social and economic development. In line with this, the Federation of Vocational Institutions of the Philippines (FAVIF) has included in its program of activities the holding of regional and national contests for vocational students on skill and speed in performing jobs in trade, agriculture, fishery, and home industries. The aim is to improve the quality of graduates of vocational courses so that they can meet the standards of modern industry.
2. In preparation for the holding of regional contests, the FAVIF is sponsoring a seminar-workshop for the training of personnel who will be assigned to plan and manage the contests. The seminar-workshop will be held at the National Manpower and Youth Training Center at Taguig, Rizal, on September 27-29, 1978.
3. Each region is allowed to send to this seminar-workshop five participants, one each for agriculture, fishery, trade, home industries, and girls trades. The participants will be selected by the board of directors of the regional association of vocational institutions and recommended by the president of the association to the regional director. The regional participants will be selected on the basis of ability to manage echo seminar-workshops in their respective regions and to plan and organize regional skills contests.
4. The participants are entitled to traveling expenses and per diems and the amount of ₱150 for registration fee chargeable against their respective schools, subject to the usual accounting and auditing regulations.

5. Regional directors are requested to send the names of the participants from their respective regions to the FAVIP Secretariat, c/o Director of Secondary Education, Arroceros Street, Manila, not later than September 22, 1978.

6. It is desired that all regions be fully represented in this seminar-workshop in view of the importance of manpower development in the present educational program.
