THE 1978-79 "LUTUING PILIPINO" CONTEST

To Bureau Directors

1 The 1978-79 "Lutuing Filipino" Contest will be held from September 1978 to February 1979. The contest will be jointly sponsored by the Ministry of Agriculture (MA), Ministry of Local Government and Community Development (MLGCD), Ministry of Education and Culture (MCC), National Nutrition Council (NNC), Union Chemicals, Inc (UCI), and Mrs. Nora V. Daza.

2 The objective of the contest is to improve the nutritional status of the Filipino family. Specifically, it aims to

- a Search for indigenous recipes to enrich Filipino culture
- b Discover the characteristics of the different regional/local recipes
- c Involve the in-school and out-of-school youths and adults (male and female) in identifying, preparing and serving basic Filipino recipes
- d Create awareness of the nutrient value of Filipino recipes and of the value of proper food preparation
- e Compile, publish, and disseminate the various recipes included in the contest

3 Pupils/students, out-of-school youths, and adults can join the contest. The contest will be divided into two categories:

- a for the 12-20 age group
- b for the 21 and above age group

The Ministry of Education and Culture will take charge of the 12-20 age group while the Ministry of Agriculture, specifically the Bureau of Agricultural Extension (BAEX), will take charge of the 21 and above age group. The contests in both categories will be held simultaneously and it is therefore important that MEC officials coordinate with officials representing the Ministry of Agriculture, Bureau of Agricultural Extension, Ministry of Local Government and Community Development, and the National Nutrition Council in planning and carrying out the activities.

4 The contest will be on the municipal, provincial/city, regional, and national levels. The national level contest will be held at the Tropical Palace Hotel in Parañaque, Metro Manila, on February 10, 1979. The first prize winners of the two categories in the regional level contests will compete in the national level contest. The deadline for submission of entries for the national level contest is January 15, 1979. The entries should be submitted to

5 The local executive committee will solicit the prizes for their respective contest winners. The National Committee will award prizes to the first, second, and third prize winners of the two age-group categories in the national contest.

RULES AND REGULATIONS
"Lutuing Pilipino" Contest

- 1 Any Filipino citizen, male or female, 12 years and above may join the contest
 - a 12-20 years old, in and out-of-school
 - b 21 years and above, in and out-of-school
- 2 The contest for this year will be on main dishes only. For the 21 and above age group, the main dish may be a single dish meal or a combination of two dishes like fish pakisw and mungo. The contest will be on traditional recipes characteristic of the locality/region like "papaítán", "pinkbet", for the Ilocos, etc.

For the 12-20 age group, the contest will be on original recipes utilizing ingredients found in the locality
- 3 Only winners in the lower level contest can qualify for the next higher level contest
- 4 The winners for each of the 2 age group categories will compete in the next level contest - thus, the 1st and 2nd place winners of the 2 age group categories of the municipal level will compete in the provincial/city level, the 1st and 2nd prize winners in the provincial/city level will compete in the regional level. The first place winners in the regional level will compete in the national level
5. Recipes will be judged mainly on 2 aspects: a) Traditionally Pilipino, b) Improvement of the original recipe (in terms of enrichment of nutritive value thru food preparation, use of backyard produce. Points will also be given on availability of ingredients, palatability, cost, nutritive value and presentation
- 6 The contest at all levels will be simultaneous for the two age group categories
- 7 Contestants will cook their entries without assistance during the contest
8. All recipes entered in the contests at all levels will become the exclusive property of the "Lutuing Pilipino" National Committee which reserves the right to edit and adapt those selected for publication.

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9 The contest time table is as follows
