Also inclosed are an updated list of the participating institutions with the UNESCO associated schools project and a list of suggested year-round activities relevant to the associated schools and UNESCO clubs which could be integrated in the learning continuum of any subject from kindergarten to college level as well as in non-formal education.

**Suggested activities for UNESCO Clubs and Associated Schools Projects
for International Understanding, Cooperation
and Peace**

1. Construct simple rules and standards for safe, friendly and orderly living to be followed in the classroom and on the playground
2. Draw pictures depicting "How Children Help at Home, or at School"
3. Discuss how disagreements and quarrels on the playground can be settled through friendly agreements just as the world do at the UN meetings
4. Tell and draw how one gets along with others by taking turns, by sharing, by respecting the property of others, by helping others and by being kind to others
5. Do simple research on how people work together as friends just as different countries are trying to cooperate with each other to preserve peace
6. Study the work of each member of the family and describe how the division of labor and the need to carry out responsibilities are happening to all families in the world
7. Show how young children could help those less fortunate than themselves by contributing money and other material things to various organizations such as UNICEF, Red Cross, "Kapwa Ko, Mahal Ko," "Alay Kapwa" and others
8. Dramatize stories about children of other lands
9. Explain how news comes very quickly from all over the world and how scientists have improved means of communication such as telephone, radio, television, telegraph, etc
10. List down and draw the kinds of food from all over the world which boats, airplanes, trains and buses transport
11. Do research on how scientists are helping the UN and other people in the world find ways of carrying water pipes to places where it is needed
12. Grow simple plants and learn that living plants need food, soil, water and light
13. Sing songs from foreign lands and listen to stories and records about people of other lands

- 14 Collect and draw pictures of animals that provide food locally and abroad
- 15 Discuss how the UN is helping undernourished children all over the world - See a movie on how UNICEF is feeding undernourished children
- 16 Prepare a balanced diet and discuss lengthily what happens to a child who lacks vitamins, minerals, protein, carbohydrates and fats
17. Do research on UN agencies which help in making regulations for shipping, flying, communications and travel
- 18 Visit the Weather Bureau and report on how it operates in relaying messages of the weather locally and internationally
- 19 Organize a group to report on daily news about what the UN and its family is doing. Make children aware of responsibilities to know what is going on in national and international affairs.
- 20 Discuss how people live in the desert, the jungle, the arctic and what the UN agencies are doing to help peoples who cannot meet their needs
- 21 Find out what FAO has done to improve production of basic foods in developing nations and how climate, land and other factors affect the kinds of foods produced
- 22 Explain how free exchange of opinions helps everybody to understand each other like the way nations respect the opinions of other nations at the UN General Assembly
- 23 Study and locate on the map countries who are members of the UN
- 24 Make a dictionary of UN terms such as League of Nations, preamble, charter, peace, translators, cooperation, understanding, tolerance, delegates, Trusteeship Council, interdependence, General Assembly, etc
25. Prepare and present illustrated, oral and written reports to the class on WHO, FAO, UNICEF, etc
- 26 Compare costs of mailing a letter in the Philippines and other parts of the world. Explain the work of the Universal Postal Union and how cooperation between countries is necessary for the exchange of mail
- 27 Record the day's temperature in your locality and compare it with temperature in UN countries having cold or temperate climates. Explain how the World Meteorological Organization helps nations to get and keep accurate weather records

- 28 Discuss how rain water carries soil away and find out how UN agencies teach people improve farming methods so that their land will be more productive
- 29 Report by using illustrations how the ancient people knew about astronomy and how people all over the world are still studying about the planets and how they share their knowledge.
- 30 Plan a music festival of songs and dances and coordinate with music and physical education teachers on the theme "Dancing and Singing around the World"
- 31 Do research on how the world cooperates to control the spread of diseases and how the UN helps through its specialized agencies particularly WHO
- 32 Dramatize a dispute between two nations and show a good way to solve the problem
- 33 Learn some principles stated in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights and translate in a language suitable to the class
- 34 Prepare a report on the work of UNESCO and emphasize the importance of the agreement among its members to make it easier to exchange knowledge by eliminating custom duties on books, magazines and educational films
- 35 Find out the extensive work of UNESCO in education, science and culture and write suitable composition on selected topics
- 36 Illustrate articles about UN and its specialized agencies for radio, posters and bulletin boards, UN events, assemblies and programs
- 37 Conduct a round table discussion on the role of the Philippines in helping realize the ideals set down in the Universal Declaration of Human Rights
- 38 Conduct panel discussion or debates on some topics as "Martial Law and Human Rights" or "Has the UN achieved its Goals?", etc
- 39 Get involved in national campaigns like Food Production, Filipino Movement, Green Revolution, Cleanliness and Beautification, Drug Education, Pollution Control
