2. As announced in MEC Memorandum No. 235, s. 1978, the program will be conducted in Teachers Camp, Baguio City.
3. Accommodation and lodging expenses will be borne by the MEC for the period of the training. Participants will pay only their transportation expenses from their station and return, and a training fee of P300 chargeable against local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing regulations.
4. Participants are also entitled to daily allowance of P10 per day chargeable against the funds of their respective divisions.
5. It is desired that the contents of this Memorandum be brought to the attention of those concerned, immediately.
