REGIONAL CONFERENCES ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF INSTRUCTIONAL
MATERIALS ON AGRARIAN REFORM

To Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Chiefs of Services and Heads of Units

and Universities

1. The Ministry of Education and Culture, in collaboration with the Ministry of Agrarian Reform, will conduct a series of regional conferences from October 16 to December 6, 1978 in connection with the nationwide implementation of curriculum materials developed for elementary, secondary and higher education levels integrating agrarian reform concepts into the educational system of the country.

2. Instructional materials developed for the following academic grade levels shall initially be implemented during the current school year 1978-79:

- a Higher Education - Modules 1 to 10
- b Secondary Education - First Year Lessons
- c Elementary Education - Kindergarten Posters and Grade One Reader

3. The initial implementation phase shall be limited to one (1) province for each region and one class for each of the specified academic grade levels in all schools of that province. The following provinces/cities have been selected for this purpose:

Pangasinan (I)	Cebu (VII)
Cagayan (II)	Leyte (VIII)
Nueva Liza (III)	Zamboanga City (IX)
Batangas (IV-A)	Misamis Oriental (X)
Albay (V)	Davao City (XI)
Iloilo (VI)	Cotabato City (XII)

4. Inclosed is the detailed schedule of conferences by levels in each region. Regional directors/city/division superintendents of schools shall decide the conference venues for the elementary, secondary and tertiary levels. Also inclosed is a list of members of the executive and specialist groups who will conduct the regional conferences, and the participants in these regional conferences.

5. Regional directors are requested to coordinate with their local counterparts from the Ministry of Agrarian Reform for the successful administration of the regional activity.

6. Accordingly, all bureau and regional directors are enjoined to inform and allow the participants to attend the seminar on official time. Travel expenses, per diem and allowances of the MAR-MEC Curriculum Teams who will conduct the conferences shall be charged against the Fund for Agrarian Reform Education (FAARE) of the Ministry of Agrarian Reform.

7. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
