UTILIZATION OF MATEA GRADUATES' EXPERTISE
FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

1. The Master of Arts in Teaching Elementary Agriculture (MATEA) program has proven to be a breakthrough in the acquisition of knowledge and in the development of skills on the subject by some 50,000 teachers.
2. In order to effectively utilize the knowledge and skills gained thru the program, it is desired that MATEA graduates develop backyard projects in pursuance of the objectives of community development and help make the small farmers, fishermen and landless agricultural laborers in the countryside more productive.
3. In support also of the work-oriented curriculum, teachers should impart such competencies as they have acquired in the development of work abilities, proper understanding, appreciation, attitudes and habits of work to children and students in school as well as in the community. Stress should be on the improvement of the nutritional needs of the child.
4. It is desired that all concerned submit to this Office a quarterly progress report on the implementation of this memorandum.
5. Please give this Memorandum the widest publicity possible.
