NATIONAL CONVENTION FOR SCHOOL PHYSICIANS

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Coordinator, State Colleges and Universities
Schools Superintendents
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and
Universities

1. The Philippine School Physician's Association will hold its national convention on November 16-17, 1978 at the Conference Hall, Region IV, Samawe St., Quezon City.

2. The aims of the convention are: (a) to develop a national plan geared towards an integrated approach for a total school health program; (b) to formulate guidelines for the attainment of its commitment to the national goals of the Ministry of Education and Culture; (c) to establish close coordination and strengthen brotherhood among the school medical officers; and (d) to thresh out common problems met in the field.

3. In view of the importance of this convention and the benefits that will be derived from it, all physicians in both public and private schools, colleges and universities are encouraged to attend the convention on official time.

4. Transportation expenses and per diems of the school physicians will be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedures. Physicians from private schools may charge their expenses against their respective schools. School physicians are likewise enjoined to attend the World Medical Assembly to be held at the PTCC from November 13-15, 1978, but at their personal expense.
