KASAYSAYAN NG LAHING PILIPINO

1. The Kapisanan ng mga Broadcaster sa Pilipinas, Metro Manila Chapter started, on June 12, 1978, the implementation of a national broadcast plan to bring Philippine history to as many listeners as possible all over the Philippines. The national broadcast is being aired from 6:00 to 6:30 P.M., Monday through Saturday, over different radio stations in different languages and dialects. A schedule of the same is hereby inclosed.

2. On June 12, 1978, coinciding with the celebration of Independence Day, the important incidents in the life of Gen. Emilio Aguinaldo were broadcasts in drama form. This was followed by a series of broadcast on the different episodes in Philippine history. The series is still going on.

3. All teachers are enjoined to require their pupils and students in all levels of education to listen to these broadcasts. As an incentive, short quizzes may be conducted on the day following each broadcast to motivate further study of Philippine history in the case of those who have already taken up history subjects in high school or college and to motivate those who are still taking Philippine history. In the elementary, these broadcasts should develop appreciative basis for the learning of Philippine history.







4. All administrators and supervisors in all levels are hereby requested to see to it that pupils and students shall get the most benefit from these broadcasts.

5. A report on this activity shall be included in the annual reports on the district, provincial and regional levels.
