FIVE-DAY SEMINAR WORKSHOP IN PHYSICAL EDUCATION
AND SOME SELECTED SPORTS

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Coordinator, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges
and Universities
Schools Superintendents

1. A five-day seminar-workshop will be sponsored by the MEC Sports Development Program Special Committee, in cooperation with some national sports association, to update the competencies of coaches, teachers and sports leaders on the different changes in the rules in track and field and volleyball, to train sports leaders in gymnastics, arts, and football and to disseminate contents of new guidelines in the management and operation of MEC athletic meets.

2. The theme of the seminar-workshop is: "Managing Physical Education and Sports for Countryside Development" and the objectives are:

- a. Analyze, interpret and implement new rules and regulations for selected sports.
- b. Acquire knowledge and skills in organization and management of the physical education and sports program in accordance with the new MEC guideline.
- c. Formulate plans to echo the seminar-workshop in the different regions and divisions.

3. The seminar-workshop will be conducted in the Bacolod City High School Paglalan Sports Complex, Bacolod City on November 6-10, 1978. Each school division is requested to send two (2) young and potential teacher leaders together with the P.E. supervisor who will pur-

sure the on-going physical education and sports program in the different school communities is line with countryside development. Each regional office will also send a representative to the seminar. A nominal registration fee of ₱50 will be charged each participant to help defray the expenses of printing the handouts and other materials needed during the seminar-workshop.

4. State colleges and universities, vocational schools under superintendents, as well as private schools may send one (1) delegate each. Expenses incurred in connection with the participation in this seminar will be charged against local funds. A tentative program of the seminar-workshop and the list of consultants and trainers are inclosed.

5. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
