SCHOLARSHIPS OF THE BRITISH COUNCIL

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Coordinator, State Colleges and

and Universities

1. Scholarships sponsored by the British Council are now available for the academic year beginning October 1979.
2. The scholarships cover tuition fees, travel, and living expenses and are tenable at universities in the United Kingdom.
3. Candidates for the scholarships must be:
 - a. Under the age of 35
 - b. Holders of a bachelor's degree with a minimum of three (3) years post-graduate study or research experience in chosen field. However, holders of relevant post-graduate qualification will be given preference.
4. There is no restriction as to the fields of study but the majority of the awards in recent years has been made to candidates in the areas of the arts, humanities, and pure sciences. Government officials are eligible for nominations under the Colombo Plan training scheme.
5. Applications for the scholarships should be sent together with:
 - a. one-page curriculum vitae, and

- b. one-page statement of the intended field
or course of study
