EAST ASIAN ADMISSIONS AND PLACEMENT WORKSHOP

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. On February 5-20, 1979, an East Asian Admissions and Placement Workshop will be held in the Philippines, under the auspices of the Ministry of Education and Culture in coordination with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. The goals and objectives of the workshop are as follows:

- a. To provide a document which will be distributed widely throughout the United States to assist all admissions officers of institutions in the processing of credentials of students coming from Asian countries, including the Philippines; and
- b. To structure a system for more accurate placement of foreign students applying for admission to American institutions which will, in turn, aid those students in achieving their educational objectives.

2. The workshop will be participated in by twenty-one (21) officials of selected American institutions of learning, among which are: University of New Mexico, University of Hawaii, University of Arizona, University of Mississippi, University of Southern California, University of British Columbia, University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee, University of Illinois, University of the State of New York, City University of New York, New York University, Indiana University, Central Missouri State University, Cornell University, Michigan State University, Northwestern Michigan College, Tulane University, and Western Washington University.

3. There will be two phases of the workshop, the first of which will be school visits and evaluation in various parts of the Philippines, from February 5 to 15, 1979; and the second, the summative seminar to be held in Baguio City on February 16-20, 1979.
