INFORMATIONAL AND EDUCATIONAL READING MATERIALS
PRODUCED BY THE PAMBANSANG KATIPUNAN NG MGA
KABATAANG BARANGAY

1. Conformably to the directive of the President to all government agencies to help the Kabataang Barangay in all its undertakings, the Ministry of Education and Culture hereby enjoins all institutions of learning to lend support to CB School Chapters and the Pambansang Katipunan ng mga Kabataang Barangay.
2. The Pambansang Katipunan ng mga Kabataang Barangay, in line with its national information program and its objective of realizing meaningful educational reform, has produced two major publications of seven volume per set, namely:
 - a. Turo-Turo Natin - a publication which traces the development of the Filipino nation through a youthful historical perspective. P60 per set.
 - b. Kaliskis Pinar - a comics translation, interpretation of Philippine History designed for youths. P5.95 per set
3. These publications are rich reference materials for teachers, students and pupils since they provide realistic insights into our experiences as a people and the principles of the New Society.
4. Every school with CB-YCAP School Chapter is enjoined to have at least a set of the Turo-Turo Natin and five sets of the Kaliskis Pinar. Secondary and tertiary schools with bigger population are requested to have more.

5. All orders should be addressed to the National YCAP Coordinating Center, Ministry of Education and Culture, Arroyo, Manila together with the corresponding amount. Payments in checks or postal money order should be made payable to: Public Relations and Information Staff, Labatayang Barangay.
6. Payment for these publication materials may be charged against school YCAP fund or from any other school fund sources.
7. All regional and division offices, through the regional/division YCAP coordinators, are required to submit a report of all orders to the National YCAP Coordinating Center at the end of the current calendar year.
8. Wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired and the cooperation of all concerned is enjoined.
