SEMINAR-CONVENTION OF THE PHILIPPINE ASSOCIATION
OF TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE PARTICIPANTS (PATAP)

1. Conformably to Memorandum Circular No. 1090 dated October 12, 1978, copy enclosed, the Philippine Association of Technical Assistance Participants (PATAP) will hold a seminar-convention on December 6-8, 1978, at the Manila Midtown Ramada Hotel, Ermita, Manila, on the theme "Technology Transfer Revisited". The aim of the seminar-convention is to re-examine and assess the policy guidelines and program directions of the various technical assistance programs in terms of cumulative contributions of technology transfer to accelerated socio-economic development.

2. The Office of the President has authorized the participation of government officials and employees who have been awarded grants for training overseas under various technical assistance programs extended to the Government of the Philippines. The attendance of delegates to this seminar-convention shall be considered official. Expenses incurred by the delegates and a registration fee of P400 per participant shall be charged against local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

3. It is requested that this Memorandum be given the widest publicity possible.

Authorized under Memorandum-Circular No. 1073 of the Office of the President (copy attached), the seminar-convention shall feature a dialogue between a representative from the government and a host country who shall try to re-examine and assess the policy guidelines and programs on technology transfer. The convention's main hall also include tri-sectoral symposia (General Government, Economic & Social Development) featuring the government's policy-makers and program implementers who shall discuss cumulative contribution of technology transfer to accelerated socio-economic development. Through these, we hope to come up with suggestions and recommendations for improvement and redirection of existing efforts of technology transfer.

2. The PATAP library, formerly housed at the Bureau of Agricultural Extension, is now located at Unit 304, Delta Motor Sales Corp Bldg, Quezon Blvd Extension corner West Avenue, Quezon City. Its present holdings include books on administration, organization, management, chemistry, economics, education, management, supervision and training of personnel, mathematics, psychology, sociology and statistics, all of which were acquired through USAID. The library is open to all PATAP members and anybody who is interested.

MEMORANDUM FOR THE PRESIDENT

AUTHORIZING APPROVAL OF THE APPLICATION OF THE PHILIPPINE ASSOCIATION OF MUNICIPAL ENGINEERS (PAMUEN) FOR ASSISTANCE IN THE TRAINING OF MUNICIPAL ENGINEERS

The Philippine Association of Municipal Engineers (PAMUEN), the alumni association of those who have been awarded scholarships for training overseas under various laws of the Government, has extended to the Government of the Philippines an offer to hold a seminar-convention in December 1972 at the Manila Grand Regency Hotel, Manila, for the purpose of reviewing the

The three-day seminar-convention is to discuss the policy guidelines and program details of the Philippine assistance program in terms of the cumulative contributions of technology transfer to accelerated socio-economic development. A series of dialogues between policy makers and program implementers at the seminar-convention shall crystallize the ideas and proposals for improvement or redirection of existing programs and projects.

National and local government officials are being selected to attend not more than two (2) participants from each province and city and send proposal to the Office of the President for approval. The maximum expenses for transportation, accommodation, and per diem shall not exceed P400.00 per participant, including the cost of their respective salaries, as provided in the pertinent Presidential Decree No. 348 dated October 1971, and the provisions of SOA General Circular No. 127, dated August 1972, on the availability of funds and the usual procedure for the use of such funds as an exception to Memorandum Circular No. 107 dated August 8, 1972. Meals and refreshments for the seminar shall be excluded from the per diem and shall be provided to participants within the Metro Manila Area. This shall be subject to the usual rules.

The participants shall submit to their respective offices a complete report on their attendance and activities during the convention as prescribed under Memorandum Circular No. 107 dated July 30, 1972, furnishing this Office a copy thereof. In addition, the participants shall submit to this Office a report and copies of all documents, reports, and materials furnished the Ministry of the Budget, and other relevant agencies, indicating their respective offices. The report shall also include a financial statement on income and expenses incurred during the seminar. Public Accountant not connected with the Office.
