SEMINAR-CONVENTION OF THE PHILIPPINE ASSOCIATION
OF TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE PARTICIPANTS (PATAP)

1 Conformably to Memorandum Circular No 1090 dated October 12, 1978, copy inclosed, the Philippine Association of Technical Assistance Participants (PATAP) will hold a seminar-convention on December 6-8, 1978, at the Manila Midtown Ramada Hotel, Ermita, Maynila, on the theme "Technology Transfer Revisited". The aim of the seminar-convention is to re-examine and assess the policy guidelines and program directions of the various technical assistance programs in terms of cumulative contributions of technology transfer to accelerated socioeconomic development.

2 The Office of the President has authorized the participation of government officials and employees who have been awarded grants for training overseas under various technical assistance programs extended to the Government of the Philippines. The attendance of delegates to this seminar-convention shall be considered official. Expenses incurred by the delegates and a registration fee of P400 per participant shall be charged against local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.



LETTER OF THE PRESIDENT TO THE CHIEF JUSTICE

MEMORANDUM TO CLEAR

AUTHORIZING ALLEGEDLY THE 1972 SEMINAR CONVENTION OF THE PHILIPPINE ASSOCIATION OF FINANCIAL PLANNERS

The Philippine Association of Planners (PAPAP), the alumni association of those who were born, educated, and for training overseas under various terms of the Agreements extended to the Government of the Republic of the Philippines, held a seminar-convention on December 12, 1972, at the Plaza Inn, Ramada Hotel, Manila, Manila, on the "1972 PLAN FOR REVOLUTION".

The three-day seminar-convention for the dissemination of the policy guidelines and program direction of the financial planning assistance program in terms of its executive committee's technology transfer to accelerated socio-economic development, the series of dialogues between policy makers and program implementors, the seminar-convention shall crystallize the direction of the improvement or redirection of efforts in the field of planning.

National and local government officials shall be invited to attend not more than twenty (20) participants each from the concerned program to the seminar-convention and shall be allowed reasonable expenses for transportation, travel, and subsistence of more than ₱400.00 per participant, which shall be paid by their respective offices; it is also agreed in the name of Executive Order No. 344 dated March 1, 1972, an amendment to COA General Circular No. 127, that all travel expenses, the availability of funds and the usual procedure of substitution shall be an exception to Executive Order No. 344, dated August 8, 1972. Meals & refreshments in the name of the seminar shall be excluded from the per diem and subsistence of officials within the Metro Manila Area, the latter to be established by separate Public Order.

The participants shall upon their return to their respective offices file a complete report on their attendance and participation in the convention as prescribed under Executive Order No. 344 dated June 30, 1972, furnishing this Office a copy thereof. It is further requested that they furnish to this Office a receipt and evidence of payment, if any, for furnished the Ministry of the Judge, and in a Diet of Manila, indicating their respective offices. They shall further file with the Public Accountant not connected with the concerned office a financial statement on income and expense for 1972 and file the Public Accountant not connected with the concerned office.
