17TH NATIONAL RIZAL YOUTH LEADERSHIP INSTITUTE

1. The Order of the Knights of Rizal, in collaboration with the Ministry of Education and Culture, will hold its 17th National Rizal Youth Leadership Institute on December 26-30, at the Roxas Hall, Junior High, Teachers Camp, Baguio City, in commemoration of the 82nd death anniversary of Dr. Jose Rizal. The over-all theme will be "Rizal and Filipino Human Rights." A copy each of the announcement and the program of activities are inclosed.
2. This annual leadership institute sponsored by the Order of the Knights of Rizal calls for the involvement of the students so that their off-campus education in the areas of character building, citizenship training, personal discipline and progressive leadership could be enriched. Another purpose of the institute is to appraise and evaluate the ideas and teachings of Rizal which find relevance in our contemporary society.
3. Six (6) sub-topics will be discussed, namely:
 - Rizal: Human Rights and Martial Law
 - Rizal and The Social Basis of Human Rights
 - Rizal and The Political Basis of Human Rights
 - Rizal and The Historico-Legal Basis of Human Rights
 - Rizal and The Economic Basis of Human Rights
 - Rizal and The Youth in Human Rights
4. Distinguished persons or officials invited to speak in the seminar will include Supreme Court Justice Enrique Fernando; Supreme Court Justice Guillermo Santos; Director-General Gerardo Sicat of NEDA; Minister Sylvia Montes of the Ministry of Social Services and Development; Assemblyman Rogelio C. Payuan and Professor Jose David Lapuz, KCR.

5. All schools, colleges and universities, public and private, are urged to send delegates to the seminar. Attendance will be official, with the institutional assistance fee of P.85 (which will cover transportation expenses from Manila to Baguio and back; board and lodging, convention portfolio with reading materials, etc.) of participants from government institutions chargeable against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing regulations. Those participants from the private sector of the ISEC may charge all these fees against their respective institutions.
