REGARDING THE EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS OF E.T.C.
GRADUATING THROUGH THE M.T.E. PROGRAM

1. Records in the Ministry of Education and Culture disclosed that there are still a number of teachers who are only E.T.C. graduates. Their failure to raise their educational qualifications can be attributed to the inaccessibility of colleges and universities. To improve their educational qualifications and qualify them for higher salary rates, the Ministry of Education and Culture will offer in the M.T.E. Educational Program the degree of Bachelor of Science in Elementary Education with concentration in Elementary Agriculture, effective the second semester of the school year 1978-1979 for teachers in the service who are E.T.C. graduates.

2. The Curriculum and the Description of Courses are enclosed.

3. Credits relevant to the course earned by teachers in the Level IV training course and in the Distance Study System for Nutrition may replace any subject of the same weight in this course.

4. General education credits over and above the requirements for the title of E.T.C. earned by teachers before the effectiveness of this Memorandum and in the M.T.E. curriculum may replace any of the subjects in this course except the agricultural subjects. A total of seventy-one (71) units are required for graduation.

5. Educational institutions with permits for the B.A.T.E.A Program and with authorization to operate the B.B.Ed. course are hereby authorized to grant this degree with concentration in Teaching Elementary Agriculture upon completion of the requirements.

6. The Ministry of Education and Culture reserves the right to grant the original permits for Malma, however, the regional directors are hereby authorized to grant renewal permits for the course.

7. It is desired that the contents of this Memorandum be disseminated to all concerned as soon as possible.
