TATAP-SPONSORED TABLE TENNIS TOURNAMENT

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Superintendents

1. The Table Tennis Association of the Philippines (TATAP), in coordination with the Ministry of Education and Culture, will conduct a table tennis tournament from January 15 to 21, 1979 at the Rizal Memorial Gymnasium. The contest which will consist of two events - the men's singles and the women's singles, will be held in order to select candidates for training for the 35th World Table Tennis Championships in April 1979 at Pyongyang, Korea.
2. The selection tournament is open to all Filipino citizens, who are amateur players and are under 20 years of age. They shall be nominated by a TATAP-affiliated unit; a school, college, or university; a barangay, barrio, municipality, province, city, or city district; a commercial firm, government entity, or an athletic club or association.
3. Five men and four women will be selected as regular candidates for training and another five men and four women will be chosen as alternate candidates. Entries will be received at the TATAP Headquarters at the Rizal Track-Football Stadium, Rizal Memorial Sports Complex, Manila not later than 7:00 p.m. on January 8, 1979. Each entry shall be accompanied by an entry fee of P20.00.
4. For more details, reference may be made to the enclosed announcement of the contest which also contain the rules and the entry form.
5. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

TABLE TENNIS ASSOCIATION OF THE PHILIPPINES

RULE ON AMATEURISM

(as adopted by the International Table Tennis Federation
at the Biennial General Meeting held at Birmingham on 28th March 1977)

Payments

An amateur player may accept during the period of preparation and actual competition, which shall be limited by the rules of the ITTF, the following:

Assistance administered through the National Olympic Committee or National Association for travelling, subsistence, pocket money for incidental expenses, personal sports equipment and clothing, cost of medical treatment, physiotherapy, and authorized coaching and insurance cover in respect of accident, illness, disability and loss of personal property;

Compensation authorized by his National Olympic Committee or National Association, in case of necessity, for financial loss resulting from his absence from work or other basic occupation in order to take part in any competition held under the auspices of the International Olympic Committee or the ITTF, provided that in no circumstances does the amount of compensation exceed the amount which the player would have earned during the same period.

Status of Players

A player who is classified as amateur may not

Be, or ever have been, a professional athlete (or player) in any sport or have taken part in any competition for prizes (other than trophies) in money or in kind;

Be, or ever have been, a professional coach or trainer in any sport, although he may be a physical education or sports teacher who gives elementary training;

Have allowed his person, name, picture or sports performance to be used for advertising, except under any contract for sponsorship or equipment which the ITTF, his National Olympic Committee or his National Association enters into, any payment under such contract being made to the contracting organization and not to the individual;

He may not carry advertising material on his person or clothing in any competition held under the auspices of the IOC, other than trade marks on technical equipment or clothing as agreed between the IOC and the ITTF;

He may not accept payment, reward, benefit or allowances for playing, except as provided under "Payments" above.

A player shall be classified as professional if he accepts any payment, ~~reward, benefit or allowance for playing, except as provided under "Payments" above,~~ directly or indirectly, for his services, apparent or sham profession.

An amateur player who at any time fails to comply with the requirements set out above shall immediately and henceforward be classified as a professional player.
