1. Permanent Residence and Household Roots
2. Medical Certificate (Nurse Report and PNP Medical Office Certification)
3. High School Card (From LSC)
4. NBI Clearance (to student whose to enrol in a degree course)

**ANNEX C: PROCEDURE**

- Step 1 - High School students applying admission to the Polytechnic University of the Philippines shall present the necessary information thru the Guidance Office of their respective schools or LSCs.
- Step 2 - Applicants for admission will get the entrance examination day of April 14 to the High School students at LSC, these are Lycians.
- Step 3 - The student who will make payment of entrance examination fee shall present him to the Guidance Office, together with a copy of his High School Diploma and shall apply to give the entrance examination card and other pertinent information regarding the admission process and the application.
- Step 4 - Admitted students whose names are included in the List of Recommended Students (which will be posted on April 14) shall submit report for interview to the Guidance Office on April 23, 1979, Manila.
- Step 5 - Those who passed the interview shall be announced in the List of Recommended Students which shall be posted on April 23 at Guidance Office and they shall receive their Interview Results and their Recommended Medical Clearance from the Guidance Office.
- Step 6 - Those who passed the interview with the Medical Clearance will receive their admission card which shall be submitted to the Guidance Office and their admission card shall be issued an admission card (Green Card) to be used for check-in.
