IN-COUNTRY TRAINING WORKSHOP ON CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT

To: Bureau Directors

1. To equip school personnel with skills in developing and implementing the curriculum, the Ministry of Education and Culture will conduct an in-country training workshop on curriculum development in San Pablo City on April 23 - May 18, 1979.
2. After the four-week workshop, the participants should be able to:
 - a. state the basic principles in curriculum development
 - b. explain the strategies and procedures in developing and implementing the curriculum
 - c. describe on-going curriculum projects in the country and how they relate to national development goals
 - d. identify problems of curriculum implementation and suggest measures to resolve them
 - e. prepare a proposal on an innovative curriculum development project which relates to any of the following:
 - 1) Integrated rural development
 - 2) Health and nutrition
 - 3) Employable skills
 - 4) Democratizing access to education at the early school levels and functional education for out-of-school youth and adults

- 5) National unity and international understanding and cooperation.
