FOURTH NATIONAL CONFERENCE OF CHIEFS AND ASSISTANT CHIEFS
OF THE ELEMENTARY EDUCATION DIVISION, REGIONAL OFFICES

1. The fourth conference of chiefs and assistant chiefs of elementary education to be hosted by MEC, Region X in coordination with the Bureau of Elementary Education, Ministry of Education and Culture, will be held in Manuel Elementary School, Camp Philips, Bukidnon on February 13-17, 1979. The theme of the conference is "The EEEP: Its Present Status and Future Plans."

2. The conference aims to:

- a. clarify doubts about the Experimental Elementary Education Program (EEEP);
- b. identify problems/critical areas in the experiment;
- c. formulate alternatives for the elimination/solution of critical/problem areas in the experiment;
- d. identify intervention programs for better implementation of the EEEP such as:
 - Project Stay and "Balik-aral"
 - The Reading Program
 - Outreach Programs - Pre-elementary Education and Special Education
 - Values Development
 - Human Settlement Goals and the Curriculum
 - Massive Training of Principals and Teachers
- e. Make plans for future implementation of the Elementary Education Program of 1977.

3. The participants are requested to bring to the conference the following:

- a. A report on the status of the implementation of the REEP; and
- b. Feedback from tryout teachers/administrators in connection with the REEP.

4. Each participant shall be charged a registration fee of P100. Expenses incident to the attendance of participants at this conference, shall be charged against local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

5. Inclosed is the Tentative Program of Activities.

6. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum to all concerned is earnestly requested.

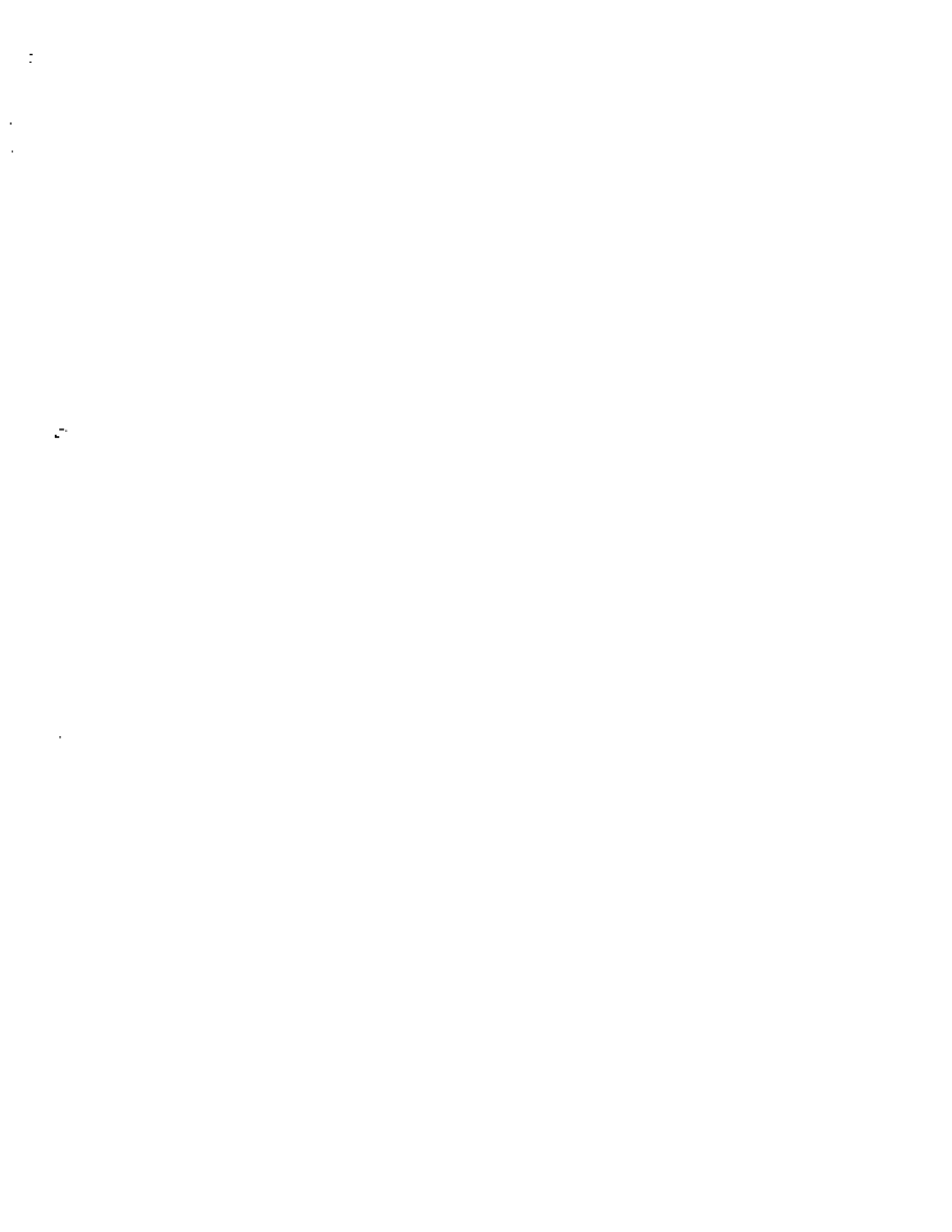
