STATE SCHOLARSHIP GRANTS FOR THE PHYSICALLY HANDICAPPED

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Coordinator, State Colleges and Universities
Schools Superintendents
Principals of Special Schools

1. The National Scholarship Center will award ten state scholarship slots to talented physically handicapped high school graduates from special schools, or any public, private or vocational secondary schools for the school year 1979-1980.
2. A local screening committee shall be formed composed of the principal of the special school as chairman, with the adviser of the fourth year class and the school guidance counselor as members.
3. The following criteria should be closely observed by the committee:
 - a. Applicant is physically handicapped, blind, deaf, or orthopedic case;
 - b. He must be a member of the high school graduating class;
 - c. He must be financially incapable of pursuing college education; that is, the parent's combined annual gross income does not exceed ₱12,000.00; and
 - d. He must be one of the top five in the graduating class.
4. Deadline for the submission of the list of qualified candidates to the National Scholarship Center is March 9, 1979.

5. The selection test shall be given on March 30, 1979 at the Philippine School for the Blind, Pasay City, and/or in test sites recommended by the schools superintendent(s).

6. It is desired that this Memorandum be widely disseminated in special schools and those schools with physically handicapped students.
