CONTINUING EDUCATION OF TEACHERS (CET) PROGRAM
AT THE BAGUIO VACATION NORMAL SCHOOL

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Coordinator, State Colleges and Universities
Schools Superintendents
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. A training program utilizing taped lessons will be conducted initially at the Baguio Vacation Normal School in Summer 1979 to facilitate the mass training and academic upgrading of teachers of both public and private institutions. The program is jointly sponsored by the Baguio Vacation Normal School and KDPITAF. Regular classes will commence on April 16 and end May 26, 1979.
2. This is an innovative instructional management program that may be adopted for other courses and levels. It is aimed at: (a) exploring and evaluating the potentials of taped lessons with print media as support to instruction; (b) evolving an instructional model based on the first objective, and (c) enabling teachers to upgrade themselves professionally.
3. The subjects Pil 403 (Pagtuturo ng Filipino Bilang Pangalawang Wikang) and AS 403 (Trends and Problems in Education), which are regularly offered under the specialization areas of Filipino and Administration and Supervision, respectively, at the Baguio Vacation Normal School will be conducted under this new instructional scheme. The above-named subjects may also be credited as electives for other fields of specialization in the mastersal level.
4. Teacher-participants may either get a certificate of attendance or credit of 2-units in Filipino and 3-units in Educational Trends.

5. To be fully accredited for the course, teacher-participants should:

- a. pay the corresponding tuition fees upon enrolment;
- b. listen to taped lessons;
- c. accomplish print media requirements;
- d. attend regular forum sessions which include further discussions of concepts under assigned forum leaders;
- e. devote additional hours for reading, research and assignment preparation;
- f. complete the standard 36-hour work requirement for every 2-unit credit and 34-hour work for 3 units, and
- g. pass the final examination given by the course professors at the end of the summer period.

6. It is desired that the contents of this Memorandum be widely disseminated and that teachers be encouraged to attend this new program.
