ANNOUNCING THE SUMMER PROGRAM OF CONTINUING EDUCATION
FOR MUSIC TEACHERS, MUSICIANS, AND LAYMEN

1. A program of Continuing Education in Music will be offered at the U.P. College of Music starting Summer of 1979. The program will emphasize an update of new materials and the strengthening of music skills and instructional techniques. It is designed to meet the developmental needs of classroom teachers in the preparatory, elementary, and high school levels in the following areas in music:

1. Classroom teaching
2. Choral conducting in schools and non-professional ensembles
3. Composition and arranging
4. Theater

2. Completion of all the course offerings of the entire program (staggered within a 3-summer period) will earn for the participant a Program Certificate. A Certificate of Attendance will also be issued for each completed course.
