ROLE OF THE MEC IN THE BLUE REVOLUTION PROGRAM

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Coordinator, State Colleges and Universities
Schools Superintendents
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges
and Universities

1. The Blue Revolution Program, a national project under the Ministry of Natural Resources which was made operational by Letter of Instructions No. 791 of the President of the Philippines dated January 10, 1979, is designed to "intensify fish production and improve fish distribution to attain self-sufficiency in fish, expand exports, increase employment, and improve the quality of life of small fishermen in the coastal areas."
2. The LOI specifically directs the Ministry of Education and Culture and the College of Fisheries, University of the Philippines System, to "assist the Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources (BFAR) in expanding its training and extension program by making available their facilities and technical expertise, whenever necessary and applicable" to achieve the goals of the Program.
3. In this connection, all school officials, teachers and other personnel concerned are enjoined to fully cooperate with the BFAR in its training and expansion program. A consolidated report from each region covering its assistance and participation in the Program should be submitted to this Office at the close of the school year 1978-79.
