* NATIONAL SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON NON-FORMAL EDUCATION

1. A national seminar-workshop on non-formal education interlinking work and learning with emphasis in productive skills and rural development will be held from March 26 to 30, 1979. The seminar-workshop will be jointly sponsored by the Ministry of Education and Culture and the Asian Centre of Educational Innovation for Development (ACEID), Bangkok, Thailand, with the Bulacan College of Arts and Trades, Malolos, Bulacan, acting as host.

2. The main purpose of the seminar is to provide a forum for the sharing of experiences among people, agencies and institutions engaged in educational innovations linking work and learning with emphasis on productive skills and rural development. More specifically the objectives are:

- a. To identify highly innovative experiences and activities combining work and learning;
- b. To plan out strategies for the effective dissemination of the outcomes of the seminar; and
- c. To create greater awareness and better understanding among policy-makers and implementors in the area of productive skills and rural development and to gain their full support in the promotion of such innovative activities.

3. The participants will consist of individuals who have demonstrated outstanding innovative work, or who have developed innovative projects combining work and learning with emphasis on the development of productive skills. They will be drawn from the following sectors, field of activity, institutions and organizations:

4. Resource speakers will be invited to discuss special topics relevant to the seminar-workshop.

5. Attendance at this seminar will be on official time. Transportation expenses to and from the venue of the seminar will be borne by the respective offices, schools or institutions represented by the participants. Expenses for board and lodging and for field trips in connection with the seminar-workshop will be borne by the Office of Non-formal Education.

6. Immediate dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum is urgently desired.
