1979 REGIONAL ECHO WORK CONFERENCE ON MASTER  
OF ARTS IN TEACHING ELEMENTARY AGRICULTURE  
(MATEA) PROGRAM

1. The National MATEA Work-Conference held in Davao City on January 25-27, 1979 revealed the urgent need to disseminate the concepts and goals of the program to school personnel and to the community. In view of this need, echo conferences will be conducted by all the MEC regional offices starting February 21.
2. The objectives of the regional work-conferences are as follows:
  - a. To structure implementing strategies envisioned in the MATEA Program based on provincial/municipal economic development plans;
  - b. To mobilize MATEA expertise for increased productivity and community development;
  - c. To develop a workable scheme for internal and external evaluation of the MATEA Program;
  - d. To institutionalize the MATEA Program; and
  - e. To further improve the instructional and managerial aspects of the MATEA Program.







3. To enrich the conference, the following topics: conferences, a demonstration on teaching community agriculture integrating various disciplines shall be provided.

6. Delegates to these work-conferences are officials and selected instructors from degree granting institutions, both private and public, learning center administrators, MATEA provincial coordinators, and representatives of this Office.

7. A registration fee of ₱100 will be charged every delegate to defray work-conference expenses. Expenses for board and lodging, transportation and other allowances incident to attendance at these work-conferences, including the registration fee, will be charged against the respective MATEA funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing regulations.

8. Regional directors are enjoined to take active participation in these echo conferences.

9. Early dissemination of this Memorandum is requested.
