FIRST NATIONAL CONVENTION-SEMINAR OF
PHYSICAL EDUCATION TEACHERS

1. The Physical Education and Sports Association of the Philippines will hold the First National Convention-Seminar of Physical Education Teachers on May 4-6, 1979 in Manila (May 4-5 at the National Library and on May 6 at the Holiday Inn).

2. The theme of the convention is "Physical Education for Academic Growth", and the objectives are:

a. To upgrade the P.E. teachers' competencies along effective techniques of teaching physical education and to show its relevance to the intellectual, moral and social development of the students;

b. To develop a keen awareness of the problems encountered in the full implementation of the P.E. program and to resolve these problems with the resources limitations;

c. To prepare for the world convention of physical education teachers which will be held in Manila in 1980.

3. The participants to the convention-seminar shall include the teachers, physical education supervisors and coordinators, administrators and physical education instructors.

4. Attendance will be on official time only. A convention fee of P200 will be charged each participant to cover meals (lunches), snacks, certificate of attendance, bantouts, and souvenir bag.
