SUMMER WORKSHOP ON THE USE OF ENGLISH AND FILIPINO  
IN ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOLS

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors

1. An intensive summer workshop on the use of English and Filipino in the elementary and secondary levels will be held at the Philippine Normal College on April 15-May 11, 1979, under the joint sponsorship of the Ministry of Education and Culture, the Language Study Center of the Philippine Normal College, the Pambansang Samahan sa Linggwistikang Filipino, Inc. (PSLF), the Linguistic Society of the Philippines (LSP), and the British Council.

2. The principal objectives of the workshop are the following: (a) to update the teaching of English in Philippine schools, and (b) to update the use of Filipino as medium of instruction in Social Studies and the Social Sciences both in the public and private schools.

3. It is desired that English, Filipino and Social Studies/Social Science teachers from the public and private schools, division supervisors/coordinators of English and Filipino at the elementary and secondary levels, and chiefs of English and Filipino divisions be encouraged to attend this workshop. Credit towards a degree may be applied for English and Filipino separately, in which case the participant may cross-enroll at the Philippine Normal College, or if qualified under the rules, may enroll at the PNC Graduate School.

4. A registration fee of ₱250 will be charged. Transportation, travel allowances, per diems and other incidental expenses including the registration fee of the participants from private institutions may be borne by their respective institutions while those participants from government agencies may be charged against local funds, subject to existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.







5. Inclosed is the tentative program and speakers/lecturers in the workshop.
