1979 NATIONAL SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON TEACHER EDUCATION

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Coordinator, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities

1. To strengthen the teacher education program so that it can more effectively contribute to the development of a socially, economically and morally sound society, the National Research and Development Centre for Teacher Education, Ministry of Education and Culture, in collaboration with the Teachers College, Pangasinan State University, Bayambang, Pangasinan, is initiating a national seminar-workshop on teacher education on April 5-7, at the Pangasinan State University, Bayambang, Pangasinan.

2. The theme of the seminar-workshop is: "Articulating Teacher Education with Countryside Development," and the objectives are:

- To identify major problems confronting teacher education, and propose realistic solutions;
- To analyze research findings on existing innovations and programs on teacher education;
- To prepare guidelines for linking pre-service with in-service teacher education program; and
- To draw up action plans for a revitalized teacher education program for countryside development.

3. Inclosed are a list of participating officials and institutions and the schedule of daily activities.

4. Travel, subsistence and a seminar fee of P50 may be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting rules and regulations.

5. For realistic dissemination of relevant decisions and agreements during the seminar-workshop, delegates from each region through the leadership of the chief of the higher education division may organize echo seminar-workshops as deemed necessary.

6. It is requested that the name of the participant be sent immediately to the President, Pangasinan State University, Bayambang, Pangasinan on or before March 25, 1979.
