PRACTICAL ARTS REGIONAL SUMMER INSTITUTES

1. In line with the continuing program of upgrading the competencies of Practical Arts teachers, the Educational Development Projects Implementing Task Force (EDPITAF) is hereby authorized to coordinate and monitor the conduct of the live-in Practical Arts Regional Summer Institutes (PARSI) from April 23-May 11, 1979, in the eleven trade and nine agricultural schools/colleges listed hereunder.

2. The primary objectives of the summer institutes are as follows: a) to orient regional and division supervisors, school administrators, and practical arts teachers in the new direction and alternative approaches to the implementation of the practical arts program; and b) to equip practical arts teachers with the technical and pedagogical skills needed to effectively carry out the program.

3. Inclosed with this Memorandum is the suggested schedule and summary of participants from each region.

4. To the extent possible, priority should be given to teachers assigned to teach practical arts who have not participated in the summer institutes conducted previously and whose preparations are not in line with practical arts. In addition, two practical arts area supervisors from each regional office, two division supervisors and all participant-school heads shall participate during the first week (April 23-27, 1979) of the institutes.

5. The Regional Offices shall determine and forward the final lists of participants to the regional staff development centers listed in Paragraph 1 of this Memorandum at least one week before the start of the institutes.

6. The regional centers shall coordinate closely with the Regional Offices and shall furnish said offices with the results of the summer institutes.

7. The Curriculum Development Center (CDC) for Practical Arts, based at the Technological University of the Philippines (TUP) formerly PCAT together with Central Luzon State University shall assist the management of the regional staff development centers in planning

and organizing the institutes, for the purpose of which a national trainers program shall be conducted at the CDC-TLP on March 15-16, 1979. Participants to this program shall be the designated training coordinators of the regional centers.

8. Expenses for these institutes as well as transportation (regular economy fare), board and lodging and training materials of the participants shall be borne by EDPITAP, subject to its usual management procedures and in accordance with auditing rules and regulations.

9. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
