DRR 1979 SUMMER MUSIC SEMINARS

To: Bureau Directors

1. The 1979 Summer Music Seminars under the joint sponsorship of the National Executive Committee of the National Music Competitions for Young Artists (NANCYA) headed by the First Lady, Mrs. Imelda Romualdez Marcos, the Cultural Center of the Philippines, and the Ministry of Education and Culture, will be held for public and private school teachers in April and May. The main topic of the seminars will be choral conducting techniques.
2. The seminars will be held on a regional basis as suggested by the NANCYA regional chairman, the coordinators, and the provincial/city teachers themselves. The dates and venues for these seminars will be decided upon by the NANCYA regional chairman and coordinators and the MoE regional directors. Each seminar will be conducted for a period of three (3) days or a total of eighteen (18) hours.
3. Music teachers with nine (9) units of Music in the undergraduate courses and/or teachers who are presently active choral conductors are qualified to attend the seminars. Each participant's fee will be determined by the regional directors and the regional secretariat for the entire duration of the seminar.
