SPECIAL NCEE 1979

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Coordinator, State Colleges
and Universities
Schools Superintendents

1. A special National College Entrance Examination (NCEE) will be given by the Ministry of Education and Culture (MEC) through the National Educational Testing Center (NETC) on June 24, 1979 in Manila, Cebu City and Davao City from 8:00-12:00 o'clock noon. Regional directors of Regions IV (NCR), VII, and XI are authorized to register examinees and administer the Special NCEE.
2. The registration period will be April 1-30 at the office of the regional directors concerned. Registrants should affix two (2) 1.5" pictures, size 4" x 1", to their application form, NCEE Form I, for identification purposes.
3. The choice of venue for the examination is left to the discretion of the regional directors. The NETC will send representatives to the said regions to provide assistance in the administration of the test.
4. The following guidelines are hereby prescribed to determine those who are qualified to take the test:
 - a. Filipino citizens who are abroad and are coming home, or those who went abroad and were not able to take the regular NCEE given on November 12, 1978.
 - b. Foreign students who desire to study in Philippine colleges and universities.

However, foreign students from Thailand, Singapore, Malaysia and Indonesia who have taken the NCEE in their respective capital cities as stipulated in LMI No. 283, need not take this examination anymore. Applicants are required to present their high school diploma, or transcript of record, as the case may be, as an evidence of high school graduation.

- c. Those who were registered for the November 12, 1978 NCEE but were not able to take the test due to illness on the day of the examination, certified by a bonafide physician or a reputable hospital.
- d. Out-of-school individuals who passed the Philippine Educational Placement Test (PEPT) given last January and February who were not able to catch up with the registration period for the regular NCEE; and
- e. Foreign high school students who came after the November NCEE and who are currently enrolled in remedial courses like English, Filipino, etc.

5. The registration fee per examinee is five pesos (P5.00). Applicants who fall under category c above will likewise pay the registration fee. All fees collected should be remitted to the National Educational Testing Center (NETC), Arroceros St., Manila, on or before May 15.

6. It is desired that the contents of this Memorandum be widely disseminated for the information and guidance of all concerned.
