1979 MUSIC EDUCATION SEMINAR

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Coordinator, State Colleges and

and Universities

1. In observance of the International Year of the Child and the Decade of the Filipino Child, a national seminar and general meeting in Music Education under the joint sponsorship of the Philippine Society for Music Education and the Ministry of Education and Culture, will be held at the Cultural Center of the Philippines, Main Theater, Manila, on May 13. The theme of the seminar is: "Music and the Filipino Child."
2. The objectives of the seminar are as follows:
 - a. To determine the type of music conducive to the musical growth of the Filipino children;
 - b. To develop the kind of music appreciation and understanding that will be effective in the life of the child; and,
 - c. To encourage instrumental playing as a musical experience.
3. Each division may send the division music supervisor, key elementary grades music teachers and rondalla directors as participants to this seminar. Private schools may send their music coordinators and special music teachers as participants.

4. Enclosed is the program of activities.

5. A registration fee of P10 will be charged each participant. Travel expenses and other expenses incidental to the attendance to this workshop may be charged against local funds, subject to the availability of funds and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Private schools participants may charge all their expenses against the school they represent.

6. It is suggested that participants avail themselves with the October 1978 music handbook, "Tugtugin Pilipino sa Rondalya", prepared by the Philippine Society for Music Foundation.

7. Immediate dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum is desired.
