AUTHORIZING THE PHILIPPINE MENTAL HEALTH ASSOCIATION
TO CONDUCT A NATIONAL MEMBERSHIP, EDUCATIONAL
AND FUND CAMPAIGN

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Coordinator, State Colleges
and Universities

1. Inclosed is Proclamation No. 1818 of His Excellency, President Ferdinand E. Marcos, dated January 31, 1979, authorizing the Philippine Mental Health Association, Inc., to conduct a national membership, educational, and fund campaign during the period from January 1 to December 31, 1979.
2. The Philippine Mental Health Association, a non-profit and non-sectarian socio-civic organization has, since its foundation in 1990, made worthy contributions to the promotion of sound mental health.
3. The Proclamation specifically calls upon all citizens and residents of the Philippines to assist in this humanitarian endeavor by giving generously of their means. School officials, teachers, and other school employees, including pupils and students, are enjoined to assist and support wholeheartedly the campaign, not only in the solicitation of membership dues, contributions, and donations, but also, more importantly, to stress the educational phase of the campaign in order to promote awareness and keen understanding of mental health in the Philippines. It may be mentioned, in this connection, that donations and contributions to the Philippine Mental Health Association, Inc. are deductible expenses for income tax purposes as provided under Presidential Decree No. 509 dated July 16, 1974.

4. Remittances shall be in check or money order drawn in favor of the Philippine Mental Health Association, Inc. and transmitted to the Ministry of Education and Culture, c/o Deputy Minister Narciso Albarresin, Campaign Chairman, through the Regional Director. The transmittal letter should indicate in summary form the sources of the collection to enable this Office to keep tab of the progress of the campaign and determine the extent of compliance of all concerned.

5. It is desired that the contents of this Memorandum be disseminated to all concerned.

PROCLAMATION NO. 1848

AUTHORIZING THE PHILIPPINE MENTAL HEALTH ASSOCIATION, INC.
TO CONDUCT A NATIONAL MEMBERSHIP, EDUCATIONAL AND
FUND CAMPAIGN DURING THE PERIOD FROM JANUARY 1 TO
DECEMBER 31, 1979.

WHEREAS, the Philippine Mental Health Association, Inc.,
is a non-profit organization deeply involved in the prevent-
ive, curative and rehabilitative aspects of mental illness;

WHEREAS, said organization during its two decades of
existence has demonstrated the value and importance of its
services; and

WHEREAS, the Association needs more members in the
movement and funds to broaden the scope of its preventive
and rehabilitative projects;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, FERDINAND E. MARCOS, President of
the Philippines, by virtue of the powers vested in me by
law, do hereby authorize the Philippine Mental Health
Association, Inc., to conduct a national membership, edu-
cational and fund campaign during the period from January 1
to December 31, 1979. I call upon all citizens and residents
of the Philippines to assist in this humanitarian endeavor
by giving generously of their means.

All donations and contributions to the Association
shall be exempt from all taxes and the same shall constitute
allowable deductions in full for income tax purposes of the
donors.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and
caused the seal of the Republic of the Philippines to be
affixed.

Done in the City of Manila, this 31st day of January,
in the year of Our Lord, nineteen hundred and seventy-
nine.
