SCHOLARSHIPS IN MEDICINE AND GRADUATE FELLOWSHIPS
IN MATHEMATICS AND PHYSICS

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Coordinator, State Colleges and Universities
Schools Superintendents
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges
and Universities

1. Effective school year 1979-1980, the National Scholarship Center, this Ministry, will award scholarships in Medicine and Graduate Fellowships in the fields of Mathematics and Physics every year, allocating one slot for every region.
2. The following are the qualifications of a candidate to said scholarships:

For Medicine

The Candidate must:

- a. have been a state scholar who have completed his baccalaureate degree with major or field of concentration in life science;
- b. have obtained a general weighted average of "2.0", "85%", "B" or its equivalent, or better, in his undergraduate course;
- c. present a certification of acceptance in the College of Medicine of an institution of excellent standing, preferably the College of Medicine, University of the Philippines System;

- d. be a resident of the region based on the location of the province/city he represented in his baccalaureate program,
- e. rank first among all candidates in the region which he represented, and
- f. be willing to sign a scholarship agreement with the Center

For Graduate Fellowships (Mathematics/Physics)

The candidate must

- a. have been a state scholar or an awardee of any of the scholarship and study grant programs administered by the Center and be a major in Mathematics or Physics,
- b. have obtained a general weighted average of "2.0", "85%", "B" or better or its equivalent in his undergraduate course,
- c. have at least two years experience in teaching Mathematics or Physics,
- d. have an efficiency rating of "Very Satisfactory" or better for the last two years,
- e. rank first among all candidates in the region which he represented,
- f. be a resident of the region based on the location of the province/city he represented in his baccalaureate course as a state scholar or awardee,
- g. be willing to sign a scholarship agreement with the NSC

3. Applicants for these scholarships should be duly recommended by the Regional Director who has jurisdiction over the province/city they represented in their baccalaureate course. All documents should reach the National Scholarship Center not later than May 30, 1979.
