NATIONAL SUMMER WORK-CONFERENCE OF THE PHILIPPINE
HOME ECONOMICS ASSOCIATION (PHEA)

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors

1. The Philippine Home Economics Association (PHEA), in cooperation with the Ministry of Education and Culture, will hold a national summer work-conference (a pre-congress workshop) on May 24-25, 1979 at the Philippine Women's University, Taft Avenue, Manila.

2. The theme for this year's work-conference is "The Involvement of Home Economists in a Developing Country: the Philippines."

3. The following are the objectives of the work-conference:

- a. To assess the present status of home economics education as a profession and develop a workable action plan on how the home economics program in all levels and areas can be strengthened effectively and efficiently.
- b. To prepare for presentation to the Ministry of Education and Culture, the local government agencies formal resolutions that are realistic, feasible and effective as guidelines to policy formulation for the development and strengthening of home economics education as a vital force to national development.
- c. Prepare a well-organized position paper for PHEA to be presented to the XIVth IFHE Congress in July 1980, as a contribution to the discussion of the Congress theme: 'Home Economics: A Responsible Partner in Development.'

4. This conference is considered highly significant because it will afford an opportunity for home economists to exchange ideas in the preparation of a position paper to be presented as a contrib-

bution to the discussion of the theme of the forthcoming XIVth International Federation for Home Economics Congress to be held at the PICC on July 20-26, 1980.

5. In view of the importance of the XIVth Congress, the first to be held in the Pacific Region and our country being the host, all home economics teachers, coordinators, supervisors, deans, heads, college instructors from both public and private schools, colleges and universities; home economics supervisors from the regional and division offices and other home economists and practitioners in the field are enjoined to attend and participate in this summer work-conference. Regional and division home economics supervisors are requested to bring their annual reports for reference in this work-conference.

6. In this connection a conference fee of P20 (excluding meals) shall be charged each participant to defray cost of materials and other expenses incident to said conference. Attendance in this seminar shall be on official time only. All expenses incident to the attendance shall be borne by the participant. For further details, please contact Dr. Amparo Sipin-Javier, Tel. 7. It is desired that the contents of this Memorandum be given the widest publicity in the field.
