RESULTS OF THE 1979 NON-MUSLIM EDUCATIONAL  
ASSISTANCE TESTS

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors

and Universities

1. Inclosed is a list of successful examinees in the Non-Muslim Educational Assistance Tests (NMEAT) for the collegiate and secondary levels which were administered by the National Scholarship Center, this Ministry, on January 7, 1979 in different testing centers of the cultural communities.

2. In the collegiate level, eighty-eight (88) out of the 1,502 who took the said test qualified for the study grant and one hundred eleven (111) out of a total of 1,623 examinees qualified for the grant in the secondary level.

3. The release of the names of 17 examinees for collegiate grant and 7 for the secondary grant are still being withheld pending the outcome of the verification of their application and supporting papers. The bases for the selection of the awardees are test performance and availability of slots.

4. The collegiate study grantees are entitled to a monthly stipend of P250, semestral book allowance of P250 and payment of their tuition and other legitimate school accounts; while the awardees in the secondary level are entitled to a monthly stipend of P200 and payment of their tuition and other school fees.







5. All successful examinees are requested to immediately inform the National Scholarship Center of their acceptance or rejection of this award upon knowledge of their qualifying or receipt of notice of study grant and other pertinent papers from the Center.

6. It is also requested that those awardees be admitted by the schools, colleges or universities where they will enroll upon presentation of the enrolment letter issued by the National Scholarship Center and that the school concerned submit to the Center the awardees' enrolment certificates, and statements of school accounts duly signed and sealed by the school registrar or authorized school official in order to expedite payment of the awardees' stipends and school accounts.

7. Immediate dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum to all concerned is desired.
