1979-1980 JUNIOR RED CROSS REMEARSHIP DRIVE

- 1. The 1979-1980 Junior Red Cross membership drive in elementary and secondary schools all over the country will be conducted by the Philippine National Red Gross from July 1 to 31, 1979. The membership fees of P6 per class section will be collected by the local Red Cross Chapter. These will be used to finance local, national and international in-school, out-of-school, and the mentally and physically handicapped children and youth.
- 2. In view of the leudeble projects of this organization and the need to involve our young people in this humanitarian undertaking, this office strongly endorses this drive and enjoins the officials, copleyees and teachers, all elementary school pupils and secondary school students to give their full support and wholehearted cooperation to this fund and membership campaign.
 - 3. It is further requested that heads of elementary and secondary schools organize Junior Red Cross Councils in accordance with the inclosed guidelines.
 - 4. Immediate and proper dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum is desired.

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GUIDELINES IN THE FORMATION OF A RED CROSS YOUTH COUNCIL

- A Council shall be formed in a Red Gross Youth-enrolled school/ college/community, in the case of out-of-school youth.
- This Council shall be formed during or immediately after a membership drive has been conducted in the school/college/community during the school year.
- 3. The Council shall be organized upon authority by the Chapter Board of Directors.
- 4. The Council shall be composed of representatives by each class on the basis of not more than two representatives per class/scotion/unit. It shall be composed of from 7 to 15 officers depending on the size and responsibilities of the members to suit the modes of the local situation.
- 5. The representatives to the Council shall elect their officers, namely: the president, vice president, secretary, treasurer and public relations officer and other positions which the group doese needs sary. The other council members not elected shall serve as Chairman of committee, such as Membership Committee, Safety Committee, ste. The term of office of the council officers and members shall be one year.
- 6. As soon as the Council is formed, the JRC Teacher-Spensor/College Youth/Out-of-School Youth Advisor shall report in writing the officers sleeted and the Council's plan of action for the year to the chapter. The JRC Teacher Spensor/College/Cut-of-School Youth Advisor shall guide and serve as consultant to the Council Officers.
- 7. The chapter shall formally recognize the formation of a college Red Gross Youth and Out-of-School Youth Council and if qualified, recommend to National Readquarters for a Cartificate of Recognition.
- 4. The Council shall be guided by its By-Laws, suggested activities and Ameticas of the Council Officers and Dembers.
- 9. Amounts to be raised by the Council during periods other than membership for specific service projects previously approved by the Red Cross Youth Committee shall be approved by the Chapter Board, the unexpended balance of which shall be credited to the RET chapter service funds, and made available to other projects of the Council duly approved by the Chapter Board of Directors.

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
