ALAY LAKAD '79

1. Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 1267, Alay Lakad '79 will be held on Sunday, June 17. The focus of this year's mass hike-out is the observance of the International Year of the Child.
2. Your cooperation and participation in this year's Alay Lakad is earnestly requested. You will be solicited to donate a certain amount of money for every kilometer covered by each hiker. The funds raised will be used for the advancement of out-of-school youths whom we would like to become productive and responsible citizens of the community.
3. Offices located in Metro Manila are requested to organize their respective hike groups which will participate in the Metro Manila Alay Lakad '79. This Office expects the National Capital Region to organize hike groups in every school, public and private, in all levels (elementary, high school and college).
4. Instructions on the Walk Group Composition, Assembly Areas and Time Departure for the Metro Manila Alay Lakad '79 are inclosed.
5. Communication Electronics Service, AFP, directly assisted by the Rainbow Communications, will establish the necessary communications network during the Walk. PC Metrocom and the Constabulary Highway Patrol will augment the communications setup and take all necessary security and traffic arrangements. The Philippine National Red Cross, assisted by the AFP Medical Support Units and Kabataang Barangay aid men, will provide and arrange for mobile first aid services. The Philippine Army, Philippine Constabulary, Philippine Navy, Philippine Air Force Bands will accompany the mass hikers. The Boy Scouts of the Philippines drum and bugle band will also be around to add attraction and infuse enthusiasm in the Alay Lakad.

6. Units participating in the mass walk shall provide their own logistical support (drinks, snacks, etc.).

7. Regional directors shall see to it that hike groups in every school, public and private, in all levels (elementary, high school and collage) shall also be organized to participate in the Alay Lakad '79 on the same day, time and date as in Metro Manila. The choice of assembly area and point of convergence will be at their discretion or in coordination with the local walk committee in their respective localities.

8. Participation of cadets/cadettes in this activity shall be credited one training day and 8 YCAP hours. The coordination by YCAP coordinators is hereby enjoined.

9. For the benefit of the out-of-school youths, especially this year which is the International Year of the Child, this Office hereby enjoins all concerned to do everything possible to insure the success of the Alay Lakad '79.
