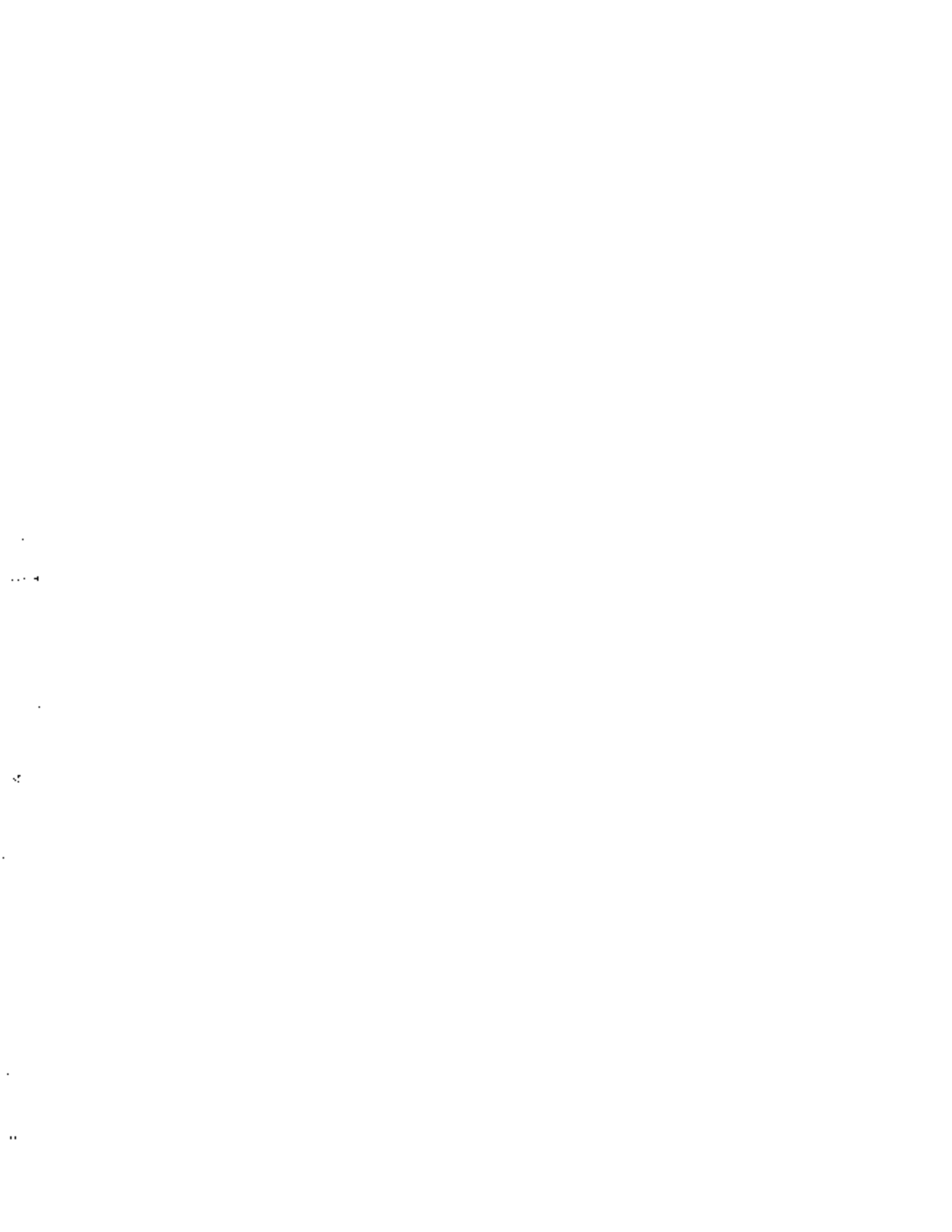

1979-1980 YCAP CALENDAR

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Chiefs of Services and Heads of Units
Coordinator, State Colleges and Universities
Heads of Private Schools, Colleges and Universities
Schools Superintendents

1. Conformably to Department Order No. 53, s. 1977 and pursuant to the directive of His Excellency, President Ferdinand E. Marcos, to provide the youth with truly meaningful experiences in social and national service particularly in the rural and depressed communities, the thrust of this year's Youth Civic Action Program shall be on "Youth Countryside Action for Progress".
2. Pursuant to plans agreed upon during the 3rd Summer Leadership Institute on Youth Volunteer Management for YCAP Coordinators at Baguio City from May 7 to 23, 1979, an YCAP Calendar of Activities for 1979-1980 is inclosed for the information and guidance of all concerned.
3. School officials are enjoined to take the necessary steps to insure the proper observance and participation of all concerned in the activities listed in the 1979-1980 calendar. Where government expenditure may be involved, restraint should be observed in accordance with regulations issued by this Office. The actual holding of the conferences, institutes and the like is still subject to the prior approval of the Minister of Education and Culture.
4. It is requested that all school, division and regional annual reports for 1979 reflect their respective participation in the various activities included in the 1979-1980 YCAP Calendar. Reports on YCAP activities shall be submitted to this Office, through the Regional Director, Attention: Director, National YCAP Coordinating Center, MEC, Arroceros, Manila.
5. Immediate dissemination of the contents of this Memorandum is desired.

June 1 st -22, 1979	<u>Echo Seminar on the 1979-1980 Seven (7) YCAP Program Thrusts</u> Delegates to the 3rd Summer Institute for YCAP Coordinators (Phase I & II), in coordination with those who have undergone this training, are expected to conduct echo-seminar-workshops on the seven (7) YCAP Program Thrusts (ABCD, DAF, ANICARE, EDUCARE, KBSS, NIGAS and STAP).
July 2, 1979	<u>Launching of YCAP Projects</u> Different regions/divisions, districts/schools/colleges, and universities shall draw up plans for the formal launching of the seven (7) YCAP program thrusts. KE-YCAP Duleman ng Munting Pagkain and YCAP organizations in post-secondary schools shall be launched.
July 9-12, 1979 November, 1979 (Semestral)	<u>Orientation on the Revitalized YCAP for the Post-Secondary Level</u> School YCAP Coordinators shall orient YCAP services on the National Development Goals and the seven (7) YCAP program thrusts.
July 9-19, 1979	<u>Organizing KB School Chapters in Each Secondary and Tertiary School and Munting KB in Each Elementary School</u> The Munting KB shall replace the Barangayette of the National Capital Region.
July 18-25, 1979	<u>Advanced Level National Consultative Work Conference on YCAP</u> July designated/appointed YCAP action officers from all government and non-government agencies participating actively in YCAP and/or with YCAP accredited projects, Presidents and/or heads of public and private colleges and universities, National Directors and YCAP Coordinators shall participate in

this national consultative work conference to assess YCAP policies and their implementation with a view to evolving more relevant, viable and meaningful projects.

August 6-31, 1979

NASSC-YCAP YOUNG LEADERSHIP TRAINING

Each school in the secondary and post-secondary levels with NASSC-YCAP Chapter is enjoined to send one delegate (NASSC-YCAP Chairman) to the leadership training in their respective geographical regions. Schedule of training is as follows: Luzon Regions - Aug. 6-10, 1979, Manila c/o NASSC, INC; Visayas Regions - August 20-24, 1979, c/o Region VII, Cebu City; Mindanao Regions- August 27-31, 1979, c/o Region IX, Zamboanga City.

Follow-up of projects

The National YCAP Coordinating Center, the Dangerous Drugs Board and other action persons of various cooperating government agencies with accredited YCAP projects shall have a follow-up of on-going YCAP projects on the regional/division/district/school levels.

September 21, 1979

Launching of LSC-YCAP Tree Planting Projects

All pupils and students throughout the country are enjoined to plant a tree and care for that tree. The launching ceremony may be marked by such activities as a parade, a cultural program participated in by elementary and secondary school children with the least expense.

November, 1979

Launching of Domestic STAP-YCAP Programs

A STAP-YCAP domestic program shall be conducted or participated in by selected outstanding YCAP students and coordinators. (Region/Division Exchange)

August, 1979

Launching of the YCAP-YCAP International Travel

The STAP-YCAP International Travel for 1979 YCAP members and other outstanding YCAP Coordinators and participants shall be conducted.

November 19-25, 1979

Drug Abuse Prevention and Control Week

Featuring DAP-YCAF activities to celebrate the DAP Week in the elementary and secondary levels. Selecting of 3 Outstanding Youth Organizations of Metro Manila of the Drug Abuse Prevention and Control Week.

November-December, 1979

Youth Leadership Conferences for Luzon, Visayas regions, and Mindanao regions for Leaders.

December 7, 1979

Launching the Search for the 1980 Outstanding YCAP Service.

December, 1979

ASEAN Youth Festival; Participation of Outstanding YCAF Youth Leaders and Coordinators

January-February, 1980

Regional Consultative Conferences on the Implementation of YCAF Action Plans

March 5-9, 1980

YCAP Recognition Week
